Assembly Member Zalatel - Muni election in progress - solid early voter turnout; potential for supplemental authorization for school district (see recording for more detail); Ombudsman report; budget process underway but timing is tricky; did approve an executive pay package but doesn't immediately implement anything; raises and pay scale expansion for other muni employees/roles; some collective bargaining changes potentially changing up as well.

Assembly Member Rivera - port revenue bonds approved by Assembly means Port modernization is on track; emergency cold weather shelter is going well - may extend through end of May (not end of April) at cost of \$1.3 mill additional; working with State to keep one (off 56th) shelter open year round; Next Step pilot program has housed 78 folks, 72 left to house, want to house another 150 by end of summer
