Aero Ave Reconstruction - Northern Lights Blvd to 36th Ave This collector street with over 2,600 ADT, has deteriorated beyond the point that maintenance is cost effective. Additionally, a trail originally proposed for the west side many years ago has yet to be constructed. Scope: Improvements will include replacement of pavement, curbs, and isolated sections of road foundation. The project will also include traffic calming measures such as road-narrowing, intersection chokers or bulbs, and other minor intersection improvements. Project is shutdown for winter. Will restart in May 2007 to complete remaining landscaping work which includes decorative concrete panels. Final completion expected late June. Coastal Trail Access from Marston Dr Rehab and Relocation A portion of the trail located in road right-of-way called Petes Place will be relocated onto the Marston Park property. The Petes Place right-of-way is too narrow to provide driveways and the trail. Scope: This project will primarily provide pavement trail rehabilitation on two access points from Marston Dr to the Tony Knowles Coastal Trail. Status: No work is underway, but a 2007 state grant has been requested. Forest Park Dr Upgrade - Hillcrest Dr to Northern Lights Blvd This local road is experiencing a high volume of cut-through traffic, primarily related to West Goal: High, Romig Middle School, and congestion at the Northern Lights Boulevard intersection with Minnesota Drive. Funding will be through the Road Improvement Dis If the project is reclassified as a collector in the OS&HP, additional funding will be programmed Scope: for an urban collector street upgrade. Improvements are expected to include pavement, curbs, pedestrian facilities, traffic calming, street lighting, and st Final report in progress. No additional work is planned and no funding is proposed in the six-Status: year Capital Improvement Program.

Goal: Scope: Replace or overlay pavement. Status: No work is underway. This is a state owned facility and evaluation and funding would be through the State of Alaska. International Airport Rd Interchange at Postmark Dr Goal: Anticipated traffic increases may call for capacity improvements at this intersection. Scope: One potential capacity improvement is construction of an interchange. Status: No work is currently scheduled in the 6-year Capital Improvement Program. This is a state route and evaluation and funding would be through the State of Alaska. Lakeshore Dr Extension/Upgrade - Aero Ave to Wisconsin St Goal: While no immediate need exists, the OS&HP identifies this as a possible future collector street connection. Scope: Improvements would include a new road base, curbs, pavement, underground storm drains, street lighting, and pedestrian facilities. Status: No work is underway and no funding is proposed in the six-year Capital Improvement Program. The project has been added to the Capital Projects Needs List for future funding consideration. The project is identified as a collector route in the Official Streets and Highways Plan (OS&HP). Marston Dr/Foraker Dr RID/LID/WID Road, water, and sewer facilities have not been constructed to serve adjacent residential lots. Scope: Construct road, water, and sewer facilities as required by municipal ordinance and codes. Status: Project has been re-balloted and the Improvement Districts passed. The DSR is being finalized for review and preliminary design is underway. Design funding has been provided and construction funding is proposed for 2008. Milky Way Dr Surface Rehab - Aero Ave to Wisconsin St Goal: Pavement on this collector street is deteriorating. Scope: This project will address the deteriorating pavement and curb conditions on a collector route by replacing worn curbs and overlaying the existing pavement. No work is underway, but design efforts are expected to begin in 2012 or 2013. This is Status:

This project will construct a missing pedestrian facility on the south side of Northern Lights Scope: Boulevard that serves a bus stop. Status: No work is underway, but a 2007 state grant has been requested. Northern Lights Blvd Sound Barrier Fence along Churchill Dr Road noise is impacting residents. Goal: Scope: **TBD** Status: A state grant of \$150,000 was provided in 2005. Design Study produces a cost of \$650,000 for the 1275 feet of barrier required. Northern Lights Blvd Upgrade Phase III - Nathaniel Ct to Wisconsin St This arterial street is a two-lane strip-paved road with inadequate pavement, drainage, and Goal: lighting, no turn lanes, and few pedestrian facilities. Scope: This project will upgrade the roadway to 3-lane urban collector standards. Improvements will include a new road foundation, pavement, curbs, storm drains, street lighting, turn lanes, south side sidewalk, north side pathway, and landscaping. Overhead ele Status: Project is shutdown for winter. Will restart in May 2007 to complete remaining landscaping improvements which includes decorative concrete panels.
