Important Public Meeting about Valley of the Moon Park

The Municipal Forester Scott Stringer is proposing a plan to cut a large number of Mayday Trees (an invasive species that has migrated from neighboring yards) in the woods on the east side of the park. Some are suggesting that we cut trees and underbrush in order to discourage homeless people from camping there. Others think that the woods are a critical buffer between the roar of cars on "C" Street and the neighborhoods bordering the park and see the woods as an important natural asset for our community.
