### Turnagain Community Council Resolution Regarding Dedication Status for all Turnagain Parkland

WHEREAS, the 2006 Anchorage Bowl Park, Natural Resource, and Recreation Facility Plan (page 4), states, "Anchorage's parks, natural open space, greenbelts, trails, viewsheds, and access to thousands of acres of wilderness give special character to the city and all-season access to adventure and nature. In return, parks add charm to neighborhoods, increase property values, and provide a balance between nature and urban development"; and

WHEREAS, the 2001 Anchorage Bowl 2020 Comprehensive Plan Parks, Trails, Recreation Policy #85 (page 89), states, "Municipal land acquired for or converted to long-term or permanent park or recreational uses shall be officially dedicated as parkland"; and

WHEREAS, the 2012 West Anchorage District Plan (page 194) states, "The Parks Plan recommends designated parklands convert to dedicated parklands..." and

WHEREAS, the 2010 Lyn Ary Park Master Plan Title and Dedication Recommended Actions, recommends dedication of all land associated with Lyn Ary Park not currently dedicated (described on page 8 and shown in Fig. 3, page 9, which area attached as A & B) and rezoned to PR: Parks and Recreation Zoning District; and

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Anchorage Parks and Recreation Department has identified parkland within the Turnagain Community Council (TCC) boundaries that has only designated, rather than dedicated, status (see Attachment C – Park List & Attachment D – Park Map); and

WHEREAS, Anchorage Municipal Code (AMC) 25.10.080.B - Use of municipal property for park and recreational purposes states, "The assembly, by ordinance, may dedicate specifically described property for permanent or long-term park or recreational purposes under the meaning of Charter section 10.02(8). Following October 16, 1979, no municipal lands may be formally dedicated to permanent or long-term public park or recreational use except as provided by ordinance"; and

WHEREAS, AMC 21.04.060.F.1: PR: Parks and Recreation District Purpose states, "The PR district is intended to include municipal lands dedicated by the assembly as parks in accordance with AMC 25.10.080"; and

WHEREAS, Turnagain residents, the community at large, and visitors to our city have for many years enjoyed the parkland and natural open space, including coastal areas, tidelands, estuaries and naturally wooded areas in west Anchorage within the TCC boundaries, and value the quality-of-life benefits these areas provide our neighborhood — and formal parkland dedication of these lands provides a much higher assurance of protection, as AMC 25.30.020 — Disposal by ordinance states, "An ordinance disposing of municipal land formally dedicated to permanent or long-term park or recreational purposes is valid only upon approval by a majority of those voting on the questions at a regular or special election";

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that Turnagain Community Council requests support from the Parks and Recreation Commission, and action by the Anchorage Assembly, to dedicate as parkland, and rezone as PR, all currently owned Municipal designated parkland within the TCC boundaries (including those specifically identified on Attachment C) as well as any property transferred to the Municipality in the future within the TCC boundaries that is intended for use as parkland.

# Lyn Ary Park Master Plan

### **Title and Dedication**

### **OVERVIEW**

Five platted parcels and one unplatted parcel make up the property known as Lyn Ary Park (See Figure 3, page 9). The much-loved and popular parklands are both important to the Turnagain neighborhood and the Coastal-Trail-using public.

Most of Lyn Ary Park property (11.7 of 13.5+ Acres composed of two platted parcels - in red and blue on the Ownership and Dedication Map) is owned by the Municipality of Anchorage (MOA) and is dedicated parkland. Two separate platted parcels and one unplatted parcel (in Yellow, Turquoise and Pink) are owned by the Municipality of Anchorage and have not been dedicated as parkland by the Municipal Assembly. There is one in-holding containing 1.08 acres (in Purple) that is owned by the Marston Foundation whose beneficiaries are Alaska Natives, including Eskimos, Indians, and Aleuts, residing west of the 156th Meridian.

All of the property within Lyn Ary Park is zoned R-1A Single-Family Residential. This zoning district is for urban and suburban single-family residential areas with low population densities. This district is governed by section 21.40.030 of the municipal code.

### **RECOMMENDED ACTIONS**


Regarding Ownership, Dedication and Zoning, the Lyn Ary Park Master Plan recommends:

- Acquire land within Lyn Ary Park that is currently owned by the Marston Foundation and dedicate that land as Municipal Parkland as part of Lyn Ary Park. (Purple on Figure 3, page 9);
- For the parcel whose title has been challenged, that land should be dedicated as Municipal Parkland as part of Lyn Ary Park, assuming the case is resolved in the Municipality's favor. (Turquoise on Figure 3, page 9);
- The parcel owned by the Municipality that includes the Municipal Tidelands and adjacent uplands should be platted as a parcel for later designation as Municipal Parkland as a part of Lyn Ary Park. The parcel currently has no platted boundaries. (Yellow on Figure 3, page 9);
- The other parcel that the MOA already has clear title to and that has not been dedicated should be dedicated as Municipal Parkland as part of Lyn Ary Park. (Pink on Figure 3, page 9);
- All parcels within the Lyn Ary Park Boundaries should be re-zoned to PR once the new designation exists under the new Title 21. (Green on Figure 3, page 9).
