ISSUE/PROJECT NAME: 4th Ave Sidewalk - Bunnell St to Boniface Pkwy

ISSUE/IMPROVEMENT TYPE: Community Enhancement

ISSUE/PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

This project will construct sidewalks on the north side of 4th Avenue. The area has high pedestrian activity as it serves students at Wonder Park Elementary. Construction will improve pedestrian safety. Design, utility, and partial construction phases have been funded with local bonds and a 2005 state grant. The 2006 request will complete construction funding. This project is a priority for the neighborhood, the community council, and the school district.

This request is for a grant to the Municipality of Anchorage.

ISSUE/IMPROVEMENT TYPE: Community Enhancement

ISSUE/PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

This project will fund drainage analysis and design on a deteriorated major storm drain trunk in front of Wonder Park Elementary School. Pipe failure and flooding on adjacent property has already been experienced. Construction funding will be programmed as needed for this priority project, using local road bonds.

This request is for a grant to the Municipality of Anchorage.

This project will construct priority traffic calming and safety improvements in the Russian Jack area. The project will improve safety by reducing speeds in local neighborhoods. A study identifying specific improvements has been completed and design efforts are funded. This grant request will be used for construction of priority community improvements. The project is a priority for local neighborhoods, the Community Council, and the Traffic Department.

This request is for a grant to the Municipality of Anchorage a 50% matching grant with local bonds is proposed.

Inadequate lighting in an area frequented by school children walking to their neighborhood school raises safety concerns. Funding is for design and construction. This project is a priority for the neighborhood, the Community Council, and the Anchorage School District.

The request is for a grant to the Municipality of Anchorage and a 50% match with local road bonds is proposed.
