Email to be sent to Scott Thomas of Alaska DOT adding to the UACC's email of June 5, 2016 regarding the Speed limit on Tudor Road.

Dear Mr. Thomas,

On June 5, 2016 the UACC wrote you our suggestions regarding the speed limit on Tudor Road. Subsequently, a number of our members have expressed concerns that the intersection of Wright Street and Tudor Road is dangerous for motor vehicles, bicycles and pedestrians. Several area residents have had close calls or accidents at this intersection. One of the latest involved a police car and another car at about 5:45pm on September 22, 2016. The University Area Community Council has the following recommendations that we would like the DOT to consider implementing to help reduce traffic safety problems there:

Add stop signs on the foot path/bike trail along Tudor Road on both sides of Wright Street.

Post double-sided "no jaywalking" signs on the median strip on Tudor Road from Lake Otis to Piper Street.

Add no U-turn signs facing east and west at the intersection of Tudor and Wright on the median strip on Tudor Road.

Add "Right Turn Only" signs on Wright St on the north and south sides of Tudor Road to prohibit traffic on Wright Street from crossing Tudor Road.

We would be pleased to discuss this further if you desire.
