RESOLUTION 2016-4

A RESOLUTION OF THE AIRPORT HEIGHTS COMMUNITY COUNCIL (AHCC)
REQUESTING A TRAFFIC CONTROL SYSTEM AT THE NEW FIRE STATION 3
LOCATION ON BRAGAW STREET

WHEREAS, on October 16, 2014 the AHCC approved Resolution 2014-07 supporting a request of the Alaska Native Cultural Charter School (ANCCS) for flashing speed control safety signs, although, to date, such signs have not been installed;

WHEREAS, in September 2016 the new Max Gruenberg Fire Station 3 opened on Bragaw Street, next to the ANCCS;


WHEREAS, during the construction of the new fire station the connection and capability for a traffic control system was installed;

WHEREAS, there is a hill on Bragaw Street at the station and school location that obscures visibility for traffic;

WHEREAS, it is in the interest of the safety of traffic along Bragaw Street, the ability of fire engines leaving the station quickly and safely, and the safety of the students and faculty of ANCCS to install a traffic control system;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that AHCC requests the Municipality of Anchorage to install a traffic control system at the new Max Gruenberg Fire Station 3 as quickly as possible to ensure the safety of the people and traffic in the area.
