



Our representatives on the Anchorage Assembly and in the State Legislature generally attend UACC meetings and make brief presentations, offering you an opportunity to speak with them directly. During a meeting, we frequently include in our agenda presentations from the Muni, universities, businesses, private developers and our standing committees about planned or ongoing projects.

People come to community council meetings because they are interested in what's going on in their local area. About 20 to 30 people regularly attend, depending on the issues on the agenda. Concerns may be new construction, traffic issues, nuisance behavior by neighbors, road construction, etc.

Recent issues the UACC has been involved in include: rezoning requests, local development proposals the proposed northern extension of Elmore Road, regulations regarding wetlands, University Lake Master Plan and most recently, the Folker Park Master Plan.
