A RESOLUTION OF THE AIRPORT HEIGHTS COMMUNITY COUNCIL (AHCC) IN
SUPPORT OF THE AIRPORT HEIGHTS GARDNER'S GROUP (AHGG) MINI-GRANT
APPLICATION

WHEREAS, the residents of the AHCC area take great pride in their neighborhood;

WHEREAS, the AHGG have spent many hours planting, weeding, and tending to the public garden spaces and planter boxes in the neighborhood to help beautify the neighborhood and to help supply food to neighbors;

WHEREAS, the AHCC appreciates the AHGG's efforts to expand the variety of food grown in the public garden spaces so that it can be shared with neighbors;

WHEREAS, in order to expand its efforts to grow such food, the AHGG plans to apply for a mini-grant for the purchase and planting of haskap berry bushes, along with protective cages to protect the berries on the bushes from being eaten by birds so they may be harvested and shared with neighbors;

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the AHGG to plant the bushes in the public space at the corner of 16th Avenue and Lake Otis Boulevard;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the AHCC supports the Airport Heights Gardner's Group local food mini-grant application to be submitted to the office of the Mayor of Anchorage for the purpose cited above.
