A RESOLUTION OF THE AIRPORT HEIGHTS COMMUNITY COUNCIL (AHCC)
REGARDING THE MIDTOWN CONGESTION RELIEF PROJECT

WHEREAS, the purpose and need statement of the draft Midtown Congestion Relief PEL Goals of the Midtown Congestion Relief (MCR) project states that this project is needed to connect commerce and community, improve multi-modal transportation efficiency, improve safety, align with city and state planning documents, avoid and minimize impacts, and maximize funding flexibility;

WHEREAS, many residents of the AHCC area and surrounding neighborhoods travel by bicycle and by foot;

WHEREAS, businesses on both sides of the Seward Highway corridor in midtown, which is the proposed project area, have both vehicle and pedestrian traffic into their businesses;

WHEREAS, the midtown area in general is experiencing an increase in pedestrian and bicycle traffic,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the AHCC insists that pedestrian and bicycle year round traffic be included in the purpose and need statement of the MCR project and that pedestrian and bicycle traffic concerns are incorporated into all future planning and development of this project.
