MEETING MINUTES
OCTOBER 14, 1999

President Sell called the meeting to order at 7:00P.M. Board Members present: Sell, Miller, Weinig, Ross, Fries, Seppi. There was a quorum for a board meeting.

The reading of the minutes was postponed until the November meeting.

Treasurer's report we have 182 members which means that 36 members are needed for a general meeting quorum.

Announcements/Concerns

Assembly Reports - None

Rep. Report - Con Bunde talked about the special session, Perm. Fund Vote, the Judge decision on School funding he thought it would be appealed.

Sen. Farnells representative - nothing to report

DOT Tom Dougerty - listened to a number of concerns that Council had about the job done on Rabbit Creek Road. Issues: Lights at corner of Golden View and Rabbit Creek not as shown on plans; Culverts east of Elmore Road and north of Rabbit Creek Road blocked or covered up; School Bus turn outs not clearly marked; Landscaping at corner of Golden View and Rabbit Creek Road being run over by cars should have some protection; Right turn lane at Golden View and Rabbit Creek appears short and very tight turning radius; Snow removal at Golden View and Rabbit Creek and at all 4 Bus pull outs;

Zoning Enforcement with Jack Frost of MOA. He fielded questions and stated that a change in "what is" a junk car. Many changes and additional responsibility to his office without increase in people. He gave his daytime office number 343-8380 if you have questions, and he also gave out the 24 hr. complaint number 343-4141.

Moen Park - It was brought up that our Parks committee was looking into the possible start of development of this park, after the request by 3 children at one of our summer meetings. The audience was asked if they wanted to see anything special at the park. Chris Hamre stated that he would like to see the whole thing a wilderness park. This will be an on going item, Barbara Weinig stated that possible TIP money is being allocated for this park.

Changes to Title 21 - It was the consensus of the board that we did not have enough information to pass or comment on the amendments for Hillside lot design, lot dimensions, and what is a hillside lot.
