#### Scenic Park View Development

Mr. Lee Baker, III, Vice President of Development for Discovery Homes was once again in attendance and provided us with an update on the new subdivision. He informed us that the swale on the west side of the property is nearing completion. They expected it to be done within the month. Once the frost is gone they will be landscaping both sides of the swale with Willow trees. They will also be erecting a 4 foot rail fence along the entire west side of the property this summer.

#### Later Day Saints Church

Robert Kalander, a representative of McCool, Carlson, and Green Architecture Firm gave a

presentation for the church plans. The church will be built on the corner of Muldoon and 36<sup>th</sup>. The first phase will be after the frost is gone. They will be laying approximately 800ft of drainage from the property line to the nearest city connection at 36<sup>th</sup> and Pioneer. They expect this to take 5 to 10 business days reducing that section of 36<sup>th</sup> Ave to one lane during that time frame.

#### **Chugach Square Mall**

Two representatives of South Central Foundation were present to introduce themselves to the community and to talk a little about what they are doing with the mall. President Katheryn Gotlieb and James Sears introduced themselves and talked about the foundation as a whole. At this point the mall is housing their Elder's program and a Daycare facility. They have just recently completed their 20 year vision plan, so they will have more information at a later date.

#### **City Wide Cleanup**

City wide cleanup is an annual event each spring. The cleanup this year will be from Saturday April 29<sup>th</sup> through the following Saturday May 6<sup>th</sup>. Let's get out there and clean up our community! Every little bit helps!
