Chugach Foothills Park playground make-over presentation

Maeve Nevins, a Park Planner from the Municipality of Anchorage Parks & Recreation Department, will present information on upgrading the Chugach Foothills Park play area with approximately \$200,000 from the 2017 MOA Parks Bond. Replacement of worn out play equipment and new amenities is planned for summer of 2018.

Legislative Report:

The special session is to focus on addressing Alaska's fiscal gap and modifications to SB 91, which is widely viewed as possibly contributing to increased property crimes due to lowered penalties.
