He’s also been generous enough to help me with those emergency home repairs that are beyond my capabilities. When I moved into this neighborhood several years ago, I had high hopes for the security a nice home in a nice neighborhood would provide. Neighbors like Steve Hickman and his wife Olga Lotosh have surpassed my wildest dreams.
