### Patrick Flynn, Assembly Update:

The municipality is still dealing with finalizing next year's budget. Patrick has introduced amendments that would restore bus service in the late morning and evenings, and he has proposed an increase to the library budget of 1/2 million dollars. He has also proposed to continue community grants for the arts community, and to continue funding for programs including Campfire and Project Access.
