RE: Resolution in Support of Rebuilding the Girl Scouts of Alaska's Singing Hills Facility

WHEREAS Girl Scouts of Alaska owns the property on the northeast corner of Edmonds Lake known as Singing Hills and the structure on that property was destroyed from and arson fire on July 1, 2009.

WHEREAS this property is in a location that allows for a large number of girls and volunteers to be supported if the structure is both designed with the intent that it function as a training and retreat center and rebuilt to accommodate more people than the original structure

WHEREAS more girls and volunteers would have the opportunity to have a wilderness experience in a supported manner if Singing Hills were to be rebuilt as a larger facility

WHEREAS Girl Scouts of Alaska intends to rebuild to the greatest extent possible in a manner consistent with the Girl Scouts practice of using resources wisely

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Chugiak Community Council supports the concept of Girl Scouts of Alaska rebuilding the facility at Singing Hills as described as long as a feasible master plan, including identification of funding for maintaining the facility over the long term, is completed; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chugiak Community Council supports their request for funding from the Alaska State Legislature.
