#### **Legislative & Assembly Reports**

Rep. Lance Pruitt

\*Rep. Pruitt gave a brief report via cell phone from Juneau. The State House is specifically focused on the State of Alaska budget shortfall and process.

#### Assemblyman Pete Peterson

\*The Assembly has approved the 2016 municipal budget. Peterson said it is \$2 million less than last year's budget but did not have the specific dollar amount of budget (operating). Here's a link to full budget for those of you who wish to see it.

- \*Peterson stated the Muni is still looking to add additional police to APD.
- \*Before the muni voters this year is a bond package \$59 million, the same amount as the amount of bonds being retired this year. The Campbell Road project is included in this package.
- \*School District bond package is different. <u>State is not reimbursing school bonds this year. The full amount of school bonds will be paid for by property taxes.</u>
- \*Assembly dealing with the legal of marijuana.

Ordinances for marijuana businesses have been approved. "Legal proponents think we are being too strict," Peterson said, "while others on the opposite side believe we are helping new industry too much. I believe we have it just about right."

There will be strict federal background checks on everyone in the business.

Feb 24 is the date when people can apply for businesses. However, Peterson does not expect any businesses will be open until summer or late summer.

\*Peterson has been participating in a rewrite of the cell tower ordinance. This to be on the muni agenda Feb. 23.

and lack of snowpack. Fire season expected to start any time now.

- \*May be able to reimburse up to 50% of costs, up to \$500, for your to create an area around your home to protect from fire.
- \*Spruce trees within 15 feet of your home should probably come down.
- \*Urged residents to sign up for Nixl.e (www.Nixle.com.)
- \*Reminded residents that many days are no burn days in the Muni. Call the burn hotline to know if this is the case. Burn hotline--267-5020.

If people are burning on a no burn day, See urged residents to contact the fire department on the non-emergency line (907)786-8900. Fines will be levied for those who burn without a burn permit.

- \*If this is a dry summer as last year, may curtail the sale of fireworks.
- \*Wood lots will be open for business. \$15 a load in South Anchorage; ER and Girdwood wood lots are free.
