 currently only sworn police officers can mark vehicles for towing  
 Voting in April will have a measure to allow other code enforcement personnel  
 to do this as well to allow police to do more serious crimes  
 Chanshtnu expansion will continue  
 Dog Park and mountain bike trail system  
 design to begin on garden/orchard  
 More parking around behind that building with Library/Boys & Girls Club  
 Russian Jack Park just started a plan  
 Anchorage has a zero tax on alcohol, new ballot to change  
 We will be implementing 5% tax for recovery/camp removal/homelessness/etc.  
 Current taxes are at the state level, not municipal  
 We don't kick people out of camps if they have nowhere to go  
 We don't do a lot in the winter as the funds are exhausted in summer pretty fast  
 New tax will help this issue

 In Juneau supporting East High sports team  
 Budget will be hot item again, not much else (that means dividend talks)  
 Believes if we approved 20 Million last year, we should make good on that promise
