Anchorage 2020 Plan - Capital Improvement Program

University Area Community Council Executive Board's Rank-Ordered Nominations

1. 42nd Ave Update - Lake Otis to Florina

Cost: \$15 million

\$600,000 Contract awarded for Engineering and Design Services to CRW.

2. Folker Park Improvements

Cost: \$300,000.

Initial Muni funds and match grant from Rasmuson Foundation have been acquired

Administrative Site Plan Review Stage

3. Campbell Airstrip Rd. Improvements

Cost: unknown

This is a new nomination from UACC for improvements between 38th Ct and Glenn Don Dr. [improve road conditions on Campbell Airstrip Road between 38th Court to

Glenn Don Drive. This section of road was never built to standard and is regularly washed out and consists numerous potholes that make for unsafe conditions. Due to these potholes vehicles regularly drive on the opposite side of the road to avoid potholes or wait in private drives and intersections while oncoming traffic takes less damaged side of roadway.

Project Scope: Develop Campbell Airstrip Road to a standard road between 38th Court and Glenn Don Drive by expanding the road to a full 20 feet. Additionally, improve subsurface foundation and resurface existing road to improve road conditions and improve overall vehicle and pedestrian safety.]

4. Folker St Upgrade RID – 42nd to Tudor Rd

.Cost: \$ 2 million

5. University Lake Dog Park

Cost \$750,000.

Modest funds have been acquired for initial improvements. [UACC wants the word “Dog” removed because the park has other uses too.]
