

UACC Resolution 2019-02

Support of Traffic Calming Speed Survey, East 42nd Avenue

WHEREAS the Anchorage Municipal Charter Art, VIII, Sec 8.01 establishes Community Councils as representatives for neighborhoods in planning and development; **and**

WHEREAS Community Councils are intended to reflect actual neighborhoods and provide guidance advice on management of lands within their boundaries; **and**

Whereas, the Municipality of Anchorage is planning to upgrade East 42nd Avenue to include new road foundation, new asphalt pavement, new storm drain system, and other improvements between Lake Otis Parkway and Florina Street; **and**

Whereas, the MOA has contracted with CRW Engineering Group, LLC to provide preliminary engineering and design services, (and has requested public input as to improvements area residents desire); **and**

Whereas, the MOA Public Works Dept Traffic Engineering Division has confirmed East 42nd Avenue is eligible for a subsequent traffic calming Speed Survey; **and**

Whereas, non motorized uses as well as vehicular safety is intended to be enhanced by subject upgrade; **and**

Whereas, widened and improved road conditions can actually encourage significant speeding.

Now Therefore: Be it resolved that the University Area Community Council requests and supports a new East 42nd Avenue Traffic Calming Speed Survey in a timely manner so the results can be considered in the CRW engineering and design services contract.
