ALASKA HIGH SCHOOL SPORTS COLLEGE FAIR

COLLEGE PROSPECTS OF AMERICA-ALASKA PROVIDES THE HIGH SCHOOL STUDENT ATHLETE MAXIMUM EXPOSURE TO COLLEGE COACHES IN 26 DIFFERENT SPORTS, MALE AND FEMALE

A lot of Alaska student athletes who could get scholarships to college never do. As a result, some drop their sports and pay for their own education; some never go to college. There are several reasons for this. First is geographic: it costs a lot for college recruiters and scouts to come to Alaska. Another reason is weather. Some sports have short seasons in Alaska: baseball, football, tennis, and track. Others – golf for instance, and lacrosse, aren't even played at the high school level.

Enter Anchorage resident, Andre Toliver, ex-pro baseball player, and College Prospects of America (CPOA). Toliver is the owner of the CPOA-Alaska Region. He is in the business of hooking up student athletes with colleges and scholarships. CPOA-AK works with over 2,000 colleges in 26 male and female sports. Through computerized lists of schools, coaches and various forms of financial-assistance grants, Toliver identifies colleges that offer scholarships to qualified students in exchange for their participation in sports. More important, he connects the students with colleges that offer degrees matching the student's academic aims.

Toliver will be conducting four free seminars in September and October to discuss the following:
