Presentations

Ed Graff, Assistant Superintendent for Instruction for the Anchorage School District (ASD)

Gave information about the proposed school bond on the April 3, 2012 ballot.

\$54.5 million in existing school bonds will be paid off this year.

The proposed school bond is for \$59.0 million dollars and would fund improvements to 40 schools plus district-wide relocatable upgrades.

The bond includes the following:

\$23.8 million for Career and Technical Education (CTE) Improvements including \$14.6 million for a new CTE complex at the West High and Romig Middle School joint campus.

\$9.1 million for Service High School

\$23.8 million for Building Life Extension projects

\$2.4 million for a Design of the Girdwood K-8 School

Marcus Wilson, Principal of the North Star Elementary School (ASD)

He is proposing that the school put a sign out front of the building that gives information about events that are happening in the school.
