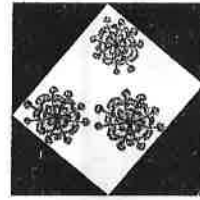

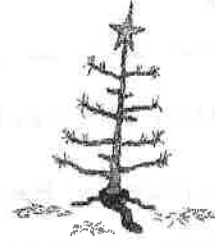
Christmas Tree Recycling in Anchorage, Eagle River and Palmer/Wasilla
