Barrett Estates/Scenic Park Estates

Russell Oswald, Project Manager for the cities Project Management and Engineering Department gave us the status on the drainage issue that has been plaguing Scenic Park Estates for many years. He said as soon as Barrett Estates got their drainage in and inspected he can figure out all the specific material needed for the job. As soon as this is done he can bid out the job. He expects the job to get underway in spring of 2007.

He also gave an update on the sound barrier along the Tudor/Muldoon curve, at the end of James Dr and Irene. The barrier will be about 600ft long and 10ft high. Five feet of the height is earth, the remaining 5 feet will be a smoky color wall that deflects the sound both up and down. It will still allow light to filter through. They will be adding a few trees and shrubs as landscaping. He expects this to be done by mid-June. If you have any questions or feedback he can be reached at 343-8196.

Once you get back to your home you need to call the number again and let them know that you are off the property.
