Minutes of 5/1/06 were approved without objection.

Sgt. Cindi Stanton, APD – dog issue – should not be running around loose, but animal control gives lower priority to low aggressor dogs so call animal control about any aggressive behavior. Animal control – 343-8118. In the middle of the night, with aggressive dogs, call APD. Barking dogs, Title 17 AMC covers animals, “8 minutes or more than 60 minutes is excessive. 10 p.m. to 7 a.m. five minutes of barking in 60 minutes is excessive. Further discussion of dog problems. Don't forget Helmet law and seatbelt law.
