Whereas current Park and Trail signage fails to provide adequate information as to where a person is, or how a person could get from where they are to where they want to go, and

Whereas the only effective way to make sure people in our parks and trails get adequate information about where they are is to provide local maps, together with their location on such maps, and

Whereas smartphones can provide location, but not with respect to maps that include properly located and designated trails, and


Whereas many people simply do not own smartphone or do not know how to use GPS, and

Whereas it would be easy enough to a) provide access to online maps that afforded location and instruction on specifically appropriate maps as demonstrated by the example below which was posted the RJS Classroom, and b) afford physical maps on trails through physical signage, and


Now therefore be it resolved that the NECC endorses both the use of QR codes as demonstrated below for use on MOA trails and recommends that P&R make arrangement to implement their usage, as well as regular presentation of physical maps at least as often as the Emergency Checkpoints and,

It is further resolved that this position be conveyed to Parks and Recreation and a response to the resolution be obtained from Parks and Recreation as to NECC's recommendation.
