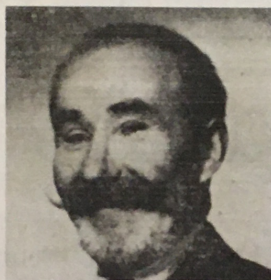
A Resolution Recommending Adopting An Appropriate Image Representing
Russian Jack Springs Park for Wayfaring and Other Purposes
Resolution Number 2018-

Whereas the Parks and Recreation Division chose to install a new Level 2 playground in Russian Jack Springs Park featuring a giant polar bear head, instead of upgrading and maintaining the multiple playgrounds already in the park and nearby, and

Whereas the Division chose a wayfaring and signage design featuring that polar bear head as representative of the entire park, and

Whereas the design is inadequate to provide the public with necessary wayfaring information, and

Whereas the park takes its name from an actual person, Jacob Marunenko, whose image appears below, and




Whereas, even those who don't know who "Russian" Jack was, do not associate polar bears with RJSP, while there are undoubtedly thousands of images more appropriate to represent the park, even

Now therefore the Northeast Community Council resolves that the polar bear icon should be removed from all municipal signage, and use of the icon cease and desist, and the Municipality should replace that icon with an image of Russian Jack or other logo representative of this park as a whole as known to community at large.


