#### III. LEGISLATIVE REPRESENTATIVES

- A. <u>State Senator Elvi Gray-Jackson:</u> Senator Josh Revak sworn in to fill the seat of Chris Burch. Good working relationship w/ Senate majority. The State AG refused to defend the Alaska Hire law (AK has high rate of unemployment). Constituent coffee meeting in December.
- B. <u>State Representative Harriet Drummond:</u> Forward-funding education budget done; hundreds of teachers lost in last few years due to

budget constraints & late budget approval. Conference on investing in early childhood education (AK is one of five with little to no budget), shortage of pre-schools, 43 other states have increased this investment. Opposes Department of Corrections efforts to send prisoners out of state. DOT & Midtown Congestion Relief Plan. Joint hearing on BP-Hillcorp sale.

#### IV. ASSEMBLY REPRESENTATIVES

A. Meg Zaletel:

Not participating in discussions on Midtown Congestion Relief due to residential conflict. Assembly in budget process, will vote next week. P&R cleanup crews to become permanent part of annual budget. AFD budget policy. MLP sale (approved stipulation to move forward). Bond for state road project (Academy & Vanguard) forcing Muni into related road project.

B. Felix Rivera:

Midtown Congestion Relief: comm council resolutions invited. Budget changes & amendments status. Encouraging state legislature to support statewide coastal infrastructure bond (ports, wharfs, AMHS). Assembly working on shortening studded-tire season.

A. Andy Holleman (ASD BOD):

Community engagement meetings. Shifting to 2-year bond package, will include earthquake repair, increasingly deferring maintenance, Inlet View (code concerns w/ current building), Aquarian Charter School.
