Felix Rivera discussed several Assembly topics - Budget cuts, Homeless issues, UAA cuts/implications, Onsite Marijuana consumption, reapportionment of Assembly Districts, Port of Alaska Rehab process going forward with \$42 Million, Storm water Utility creation considerations with 1.5 Million as seed funding. Also discussed was the ML&P pending sale to CEA.

2. 6:15 : Discussion by Solid Waste/Dowl on the New Transfer Station design, impacts, costs, etc. A 2020 start date was discussed for the ~\$74 Million project.

3. Wende Wilbur discussed the plans for a Panda Express venue on Dimond Blvd, 2020 construction start anticipated.

4. 6:31 Felix Rivera discussed the upcoming US Census process and the several work areas that need to be filled for it.

5. 6:33 Meg Zaletel discussed cell phone use in MOA, the plastic shopping bag ban and added some details to the State driven UAA budget cut consequences.

6. 6:45 Council Discussion: Jeff Schmitz expressed the Councils thanks for the consistent efforts regarding the chronic homeless issues and Assembly/MOA efforts to mitigate them. The question was asked as to whether ongoing camp abatement would continue into early winter, the answer was yes.
