Sen. Elvi Gray-Jackson

Jacob Tatum informed us that there are three companion bills put forward in the Senate. The first presents a timeline in which the state will end the backlog of sexual assault kits waiting to be examined. The second will outlaw private prisons in the state. The third will expand the number of health care professionals in the state who can prescribe the disabled placards that permit vehicles to park in the designated spaces.

Is taking on more responsibilities and duties, and accordingly recently attended training on the Land Claims Act and Tribal Compacts. He is also delving into school system management and sentencing guidelines.
