

Suggestions Needed for Capital Projects in our Council Area.

At our March 6th Council meeting you will be asked to suggest and discuss possible Scenic Foothills Capital Projects. We will mail a survey with our April Newsletter asking members to register their Capital Project preferences. There will be one additional opportunity to do so at our April 3rd meeting. Based on all responses, the Board will compile a final list of priorities and forward it to the Municipal Budget Office and to our Assembly representatives. This list is key to our council area being able to obtain the improvements we will be seeking over the next 5 years.

Last year our priorities were the following:

- 1. Scenic Park drainage improvements
- 2. Muldoon Road pedestrian improvements
- 3. Bike trail connection- Chugach Estates to Chugach Foothills Park
- 4. Land acquisition to Chugach Foothills Park at 36th
- 5. East Anchorage park acquisition
- 6. Muldoon Recreation Center
- 7. 36th Ave. & Muldoon intersection upgrade
- 8. 32nd Ave. & Muldoon upgrades
- 9. Baxter Bog trail improvements
- 10. Eastside ball fields study

MEET THE CANDIDATES LEARN ABOUT THE BONDS AND PROPOSITIONS MARCH 6TH COUNCIL MEETING

Bond issues of particular interest to our Council area are the Baxter Bog Trail Improvement funds contained in the Parks bonds, and Phase 2 of the Patterson Road Upgrade in the Roads Improvement bond.
