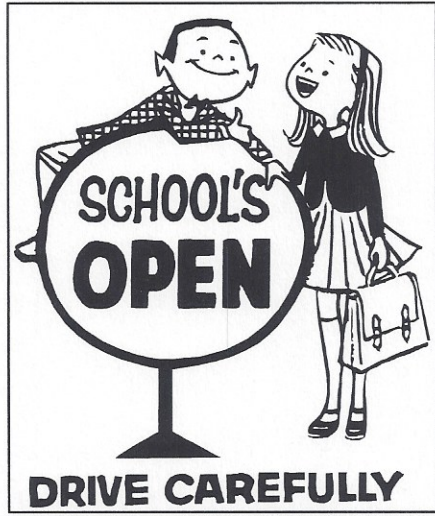

### School Bond

A representative of the Anchorage School District will discuss at our Council meeting the upcoming school bond proposals, particularly the impact on the proposed Creekside Middle School.

School enrollment has been changing, but the projections for the Eastside is a disproportionate increase in students.

### Schools-No Child Left Behind

Anchorage School District will also describe the effects of No Child Left Behind requirements on schools of the Eastside. Measures for remediation and the option for school transfer will also be discussed

### Other school issues

Anchorage School District is reviewing proposals to consolidate some of its services. One such proposal would renovate the eastern portion of the Boniface Mall. If there is any progress on these proposals, ASD will discuss it at our Council meeting.

### Will Scenic Park ever drain properly?

Russ Oswald, Project Engineer for the Municipality, will update us on the status of Scenic Park drainage solutions. Costs estimates for a new lift station and new storm drain connection are being submitted. We are hopeful for an agreement and construction soon.

### Baxter Bog Park

To no avail, we have been trying all summer to get someone from the Muni Parks Department to describe what would be an allowable wetlands solution to the flooding of the trails around Baxter Bog. To date, they have not been responsive and we have probably lost the opportunity for a work party this summer. If you are still available to help out in late September, please contact Roger Shaw or Lee Walker. We will definitely work on this project next summer.

### Landscaping and pedestrian trail

It is so pleasing to see the new landscaping along Muldoon Road and a new pedestrian/bike trail segment. We continue to request development of the segment which would connect the trail around the Tudor/Muldoon curve.
