A DOG PARK Ordinance #2003-108 has been presented by Assembly Chair, Dick Traini, supported by Doug Van Etten. A dog park is an area where dogs are allowed to be off leash. The ordinance names one area only, University Lake, a neighborhood park. The only time for a public hearing will be at the Tuesday, July 22 Assembly meeting. The Assembly expects to vote on the ordinance that same evening. The UACC Executive Board met July 7, finding the present ordinance unacceptable for the following reasons:

- There is a small amount of municipal land around University Lake. Alaska Pacific University owns a majority of the land.
- The University Lake area has been treated as a neighborhood park for approximately 30 years.
- The trails around the lake are classified multi purpose.
- The lake is a waterfowl nesting area.
- No Master Plan has been established for the park due to lack of funds.

We, the executive board, are disappointed to find that University Lake Park is the only location mentioned in the proposed ordinance. No explanation from any assembly member has been given as to why this ordinance is limited to one location.
