DELANEY PARK MASTER PLAN – UPDATE

The Municipality has prepared a **draft Delaney Park Master Plan for public review**. The Muni is asking that the public review the document and **provide comments** to the planning team **by January 5, 2007**.

Delaney Park is one of Anchorage's oldest and most important public spaces and is currently without an approved master plan. This draft incorporates the work of the Delaney Park Community Advisory Group as well as input gathered from a 2-day public workshop in 2005. As other plans within Downtown Anchorage progress, including the Downtown Plan, E Street Corridor, F Street and 9th Avenue, it is important to ensure that all of the projects work together to make the heart of the city vibrant and diverse.
