## AIRPORT HEIGHTS COMMUNITY COUNCIL RESOLUTION 2020-5

A RESOLUTION OF THE AIRPORT HEIGHTS COMMUNITY COUNCIL THAT REQUESTS THE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY TO EXTEND THE EXISTING COVID-19 EMERGENCY DECLARATION BEYOND NOVEMBER 30, 2020

WHEREAS, the general membership of the Airport Heights Community Council (AHCC), is not scheduled to meet until November 19, 2020 and there is urgency to have the subject of this resolution acted upon before the next general membership meeting;

WHEREAS, according to the AHCC bylaws, the executive board is authorized to make decisions and speak on behalf of the council when the general membership is unable to do so;

WHEREAS, the executive board met on November 7, 2020 to discuss the subject matter of this resolution and approved the following;

WHEREAS, there has been a recent surge of COVID-19 cases in the Municipality of Anchorage that suggests the need to take extraordinary measures to reduce the outbreak of new COVID-19 cases by the extension of the COVID – 19 Emergency Declaration;

WHEREAS, THE Municipal Assembly will address an extension of the COVID-19 Emergency Declaration beyond 11/30/20;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Airport Heights Community Council through its executive board urges the Municipal Assembly to extend the existing COVID-19 Emergency Declaration beyond November 30, 2020.

THIS RESOLUTION WAS APPROVED by the Airport Heights Community Council executive board on November 7, 2020 and will be presented to the full council membership at the next regularly scheduled on meeting on November 19, 2020.
