1. Dowl Engineering Update on the new Solid Waste transfer facility and progress thereon, Trina Stewart
2. A Parks & Rec Campbell Creek Trail Reconstruction Schedule Update was given for Maeve Nevins Lavtar by Jeff Schmitz. Permitting issues set the planned Fairbanks St bridge replacement back, this is now scheduled to be done in 2021.
3. Al's Bar, Janie Odgers, Shareen Crosby
Extensive discussion on the subject of Al's Bar (Al's Alaskan Inn, 7830 Old Seward Hwy) and the adverse impacts, code violations, excessive calls to APD, fights in the parking lot, shots fired on multiple occasions, permit violations and a SWAT team incident. As of this meeting date there was believed to be at least one code issue outstanding with the AFD Fire Marshall section.
4. There is a problem with excessive junk vehicles at a property in the 76th & Evander location.
5. Carl Jacobs, School Board candidate discussed his interest in the election.
6. Donna Williams discussed crime and break in issues at her 420 - 480 E. 56th St condo complex, the break ins are in the common garage areas which preclude being logged as burglary incidents, rather they are classified as "other".
