A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING TRANSFER OF THE MOUNTAIN VIEW COMMUNITY PATROL VEHICLE AND ADMINISTRATION TO THE ANCHORAGE COALITION OF COMMUNITY PATROLS

WHEREAS the Mountain View Community Patrol, under the control of the Mountain View Community Council, has struggled to recruit new volunteers and maintain neighborhood participation, and

WHEREAS the Mountain View Community Patrol has now been inactive for more than a year,

WHEREAS maintaining the inactive Mountain View Community Patrol vehicle comes at a substantial annual cost to the Mountain View Community Council, and

WHEREAS funds currently spent on Mountain View Community Patrol vehicle maintenance could help support alternative neighborhood safety initiatives with broader community volunteer support, and

WHEREAS the Mountain View Community Patrol would be more appropriately administered through the Anchorage Coalition of Community Patrols,

BE IT RESOLVED: The Mountain View Community Council authorizes transferring the Mountain View Community Patrol vehicle and administration to the Anchorage Coalition of Community Patrols.
