### What is a community council?

The purpose of the Community Council is to provide a direct and continuing means of citizen participation in local affairs. HOCC is part of a network of Community Councils under the Federation of Community Councils supported by the Municipality.

### What does a board member do?

Attend a 1x a monthly board meeting, and 1x a monthly council meeting. There are also committees that work on various issues outside these two sessions.

**Why is it important?** It gives residents an opportunity to have a voice with the Anchorage Assembly, Mayor's administration, and boards and commissions that make decisions for your area!

**What are the requirements?** You must reside or own property within the boundaries of HOCC and have attended at least two meetings in the last 12 months. Also, you need to have a commitment to be at the meetings and an enthusiasm to help our community!
