SUBJECT: Case No. 2007- 015. Conditional Use Liquor Permit for Café Polonia

NOTE: The NECC Board has the authority to act as representatives of the NECC membership on time sensitive issues. Given that comments are due January 12 and our next membership meeting is January 18, we elected to comment on this item at our board meeting.

At the NECC Board meeting on January 4, 2007, a presentation on a proposed beer and wine license for the "Café Polonia restaurant was made by the petitioner, Robert Burlinski. The Alcohol Committee of NECC also made a presentation and recommendation regarding the issuing of this permit.

After some discussion, and as this beer and wine license is associated with a restaurant and is not a retail license or for a bar, the following motion in support of this license was made:

NECC January 4, 2007 Motion (1):

The NECC Board of Directors supports a conditional use permit for the Café Polonia for beer and wine sales for onsite consumption only, limited to their current hours of operation.

Motion passed: 7 in favor, 0 opposed.

The only neighborhood concern expressed to the committee was concerning very late night traffic congestion and littering in the alley behind the mall this restaurant is located in. However, those problems are most likely caused by the Last Frontier Bar located in the same mall. We have alerted the Anchorage Police Department of this concern.

We ask that you act upon this motion as warranted in the interests of the NECC and the community of Anchorage as a whole. Thank you for your attention to this matter.
