• MOA Assembly update (Kevin Cross, Jamie Allard)

- o Assemblywoman Jamie Allard:
 - Allard, navigation center passed. Because there is no facilities, they were going to suggest bringing people to CER, Mac Center, and Spenard, but that is not going to happen.
 - Mayor said that he would have the navigation center by November, six weeks
 - Budget was approved, but the mayor didn't like a few things, tomorrow meeting for the assembly to vote to override the veto. It may not work Zaletel is out of the country.
 - ARPA funds:
 - South Anchorage got 5.5 million to build a health center.
 - Eagle River barely got 1 million.
 - Allard suggests the community bring buckets to see what areas need funding.
 - "Baseball" other projects, and she needs to know if we can find suggestions.
 - Elks are getting 29K within the next thirty days. Fraternity orders get all around the municipality (\$60 K)
 - AO in May change the code, legislative and executive are not going along.
 - Resolution to honor Asian Pacific Islanders resolution
 - Cash assets and liability with the Muni manager and Mayor, Eagle Exit related.
 - 1.5 million coming out of the Muni for Avalanche removal.
 - Sullivan arena is going to get shut down, and Sockeye Inn also removed the people due to remodeling.
 - Allard is concerned about more homeless people in the community in the streets and perhaps coming to Eagle River.
