Support for speed bumps, Mike Hanna: Robin Street needs speed bumps to curb speeding at strategic location in the neighborhood.

What is CIP list-survey? Karen Bronga: encouraged all to express priorities in this survey.

Clean up day, Kathleen Chamberlain: sponsored by Anchorage Chamber of Commerce with free bags and dump passes.

School board, Dora Wilson: new superintendent starts May 16.

JBER, Joy Boston: Boniface gate open and Fort Richardson gate closed.
