2024 Spenard Capital Improvement Program Priorities

The Spenard Community Council Executive Board introduced the priority ranking process for our 2024 Capital Improvement Program at our March 1, 2023 meeting. Members were asked to fill out a survey via a link shared by email and through social media or by a paper survey available at the April 5, 2023 meeting. We had 20 responses from SCC members (and 4 from outside, not included in our results). Priority projects will be approved and moved into the 2024-2029 Capital Improvement Program. Projects suggested will be added to the 2025 Capital Improvement Program survey distributed by SCC.

The Spenard Community Council general membership requests the adoption of this list for our 2024 CIP priorities:

- 1. Lois Dr Upgrade Northern Lights Blvd to 36th Ave road, sidewalks, storm drainage, etc
- 2. Fish Creek Daylighting: bring it out of culverts as a free-flowing creek
- 3. Spenard Rd Rehabilitation Benson Blvd to Minnesota Dr
- 4. Pedestrian Crossings/Traffic Calming: Minnesota Boulevard from International to Northern Lights Boulevard
- 5. Spenard Rd Reconstruction Phase III 30th Ave to Northwood Dr
- 6. 36th Ave Upgrade Lois Dr to Minnesota Dr: surface, sidewalks, drainage, etc.
- 7. Chugach Way Upgrade Spenard Rd to Arctic Blvd
- 8. Spenard Area Railroad Crossing Pedestrian Safety Improvements
- 9. Lois Dr Pathway Benson Blvd to 32nd Ave
- 10. Fireweed Ln Reconstruction Spenard Rd to Seward Hwy
- 11. Northwood Park safety improvements
- 12. W Tudor Rd Pathway Connection: sidewalks near Spenard Builders Supply crossing railroad
- 13. Ure Park improvements
- 14. West 45th Avenue road surface Taft St to Northwood Dr
