1) Safer Streets for Biking in Anchorage: Pilot Protected Bike Lane Now Open

Anchorage’s first Protected Bike Lane (PBL) is now open as a pilot project along Pine Street and McCarrey Street. The PBL Pilot Study aims to learn how protected bike lanes can be implemented to improve and provide safe, reliable access for pedestrians, bicycles, and transit riders. Come experience the temporary installations in the Pilot Study Corridor along Pine Street and McCarrey Street.
