- HB 119 is going through Labor and Commerce.
- January 16th the are back in session.

#### **Bob with FCC update**

- When ASD has remote learning days vs. snow days, they do not need to add days to the school year.
- Employment/ Economy are relatively good but the lower 48 is stronger.
- For employment, there are 2 jobs available for every person looking for work.
- FCC budget is currently \$92K per year and they want to increase it to \$204K to allow for a Director position.

## Kelly Lessens update

- ASD Board is meeting next Tuesday.
- They are looking at steps to decrease healthcare costs.
- 24-25 school year they are currently looking at a \$95 million deficit.
- They are planning on rebuilding Inlet View elementary for \$18 million.
- The Alaska Association of School Boards is promoting and increase to the BSA of \$1,655.
- Question- What is being done about the books in the schools that are not appropriate for kids and indoctrination?
- Answer- The board doesn't make determinations on specific books. There is already a mechanism
