2024 Arctic Winter Games

The 2024 Arctic Winter Games - a biennial multi-sport and cultural event hosted by contingents in the Arctic region, specifically focusing on circumpolar communities from areas like Canada, Alaska, Kalaallit Nunaat, and Northern Scandinavia – are being hosted this year in Alaska with all competition happening in the Mat-Su valley. This event will bring in thousands of athletes, spectators, and volunteers to the airport. All athlete arrivals will happen Friday, March 8 and Saturday, March 9. The most impacted part of the airport will be the North Terminal when over 1500 athletes and families will arrive there on Saturday via charter flights.

Wind

ANC Airport have been facing severe winds the past couple weeks, with some days getting upwards of 50 knots (57 mph). ANC Operations, in coordination with various groups including the FAA, cargo, and passenger airlines, managed safe landings and takeoffs in real-time during inclement weather. Additionally, ANC airfield maintenance worked diligently to keep runways clear of snow and debris.
