Substation Rebuild Update, Including Design Choices for Substation Wall

Chugach Electric Association, Inc. (Chugach) is inviting you to a community meeting for an update on the Campbell Lake Substation Rebuild as well as to provide additional information based on earlier feedback from the community. We are hosting the meeting at the **Bayshore Clubhouse** (3131 Amber Bay Loop) on May 7 from 6:30 to 7:30 pm.

As has been previously communicated, the substation, located at 10000 Southport Drive, has been in operation since 1976. Due to its age, the substation equipment has reached the end of its designed, useful life and needs to be rebuilt to handle current and future electric loads, as well as ensure a safe and secure electric distribution system.

This work will also ensure reliability for those living along Dimond Boulevard, Arlene, Bayshore, Old Klatt neighborhoods, and developments along 100th Avenue, along Jewel Lake Road, and 84th Avenue. Construction is tentatively scheduled to start in July of this year.

We have participated in multiple meetings with the Chugach members impacted by this project and, based on what we heard at our last meeting, we have made some modifications to the design we'd like to share with you. On the back of this letter, there are three choices for the wall around the substation that we'd like you to review and choose your favorite. You can bring the flyer and your choice to the meeting, or mail it to the following by May 6:
