

Fairview Community Council, Inc. Executive Board Minutes - FINAL -

December 4, 2008

The Fairview Community Council held its monthly executive board meeting at the Fairview Community Recreation Center Thursday, December 4, 2008. The president called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM.

1 Sharon CHAMARD - President

The president met with the Spenard Community Council in an effort to help keep the CAPS team here in Fairview. The president suggested that Public Safety Committee work with Spenard to train people to be observers. She suggested putting together a booklet on the subject and perhaps preparing forms for gathering information. Things are moving ahead with the oral history report, but much of the oral history so far relates to events that occurred outside of Fairview or even outside of Anchorage. The president would like to see more oral history relating to events in Fairview. The president introduced a resolution to encourage the municipality to schedule construction of the Cordova to Latouche section of 9th Avenue project for the 2009 construction season - referred to Revitalization Committee. The president passed out a resolution from Mountain View Community Council in support of state funding for public transportation operations - referred to *Revitalization Committee.

ROSS mentioned that a letter should be written to liquor store owners about communicating to avoid selling to inebriates.
