APD Report- Sgt. Denny Allen

Sgt. Allen passed around 'wanted' posters for two characters wanted for forgery who had been reported to be hanging around Fairview, seen recently at Spirits of Alaska liquor store and 13th & Juneau area. Urged anyone who might have info to call Crime Stoppers for \$1,000 reward (561-STOP).

Reported 435 police reports for January. Spread evenly across CC area, not any one spot.

There is a fence around 3rd & Ingra property now (old hospital site). Watch for campers.

DH asked if APD had an opinion on the 'legal' camp idea. APD does not like it and does not support it.

Ron Aleva about the issue of labeling drivers licenses so convicted alcohol offenders could not purchase alcohol (nothing new)

RA asked about recent death at 6th & Karluk and whether it was alcohol related (don't know)

Paul (?) from Carrs said store had recently located mouthwash behind the counter in an effort to remove this as an alcohol source for street people.

Assembly Report- No Assembly report

President's Report:

- Darrel updated the Membership on the 16th Avenue Terrace Project. We should see design concepts in May. This month the City will be closing on one property and is still negotiating with the owner of the other property. The 9th Ave Project, which was originally just a re-pave, until the FVCC asked to have the project re-scoped to include landscaping and streetscape elements, is moving along. USKH will have conceptual designs for us in June or July.
- John Dean caught up with Sharon at Citizens Academy, will proactively be doing Code Enforcement.
- No newsletters for January or February because Darrel had been ill, busy working and moving.

- Sarah Wilson-Doyle and Laura Mancini from Land Design North had presentation for the United Way Day of Caring Project. Member mentioned that the Web had many people who would be glad to volunteer for these projects.
- Nine Star's new programs-Dale Myhill presented Education and Employment Services, a new program run by Thea Fields-Lathan. Member Diane Johnson asked how to retain someone for her

firm for a new entry level position she had open. Jerry Richardson runs CPR program. CPR stands for the Coalition for Prisoner Re-entry. He distributed flyers that just came from the printer. Diane Johnson asked how to hire someone on through this program. Dale gave her a brochure. Ron Aleva asked how this would affect Fairview. They explained that it doesn't just affect Fairview, this is just a referral program for programs that already exist and would affect the whole town.
