Pending Assembly Amendment of the MOA Sign Ordinance

At the June 16, 2005 general membership meeting of the NECC, recent assembly actions amending the MOA Sign Ordinance were discussed. There was considerable concern about possible proposals to eliminate the amortization schedule (i.e. phase in period), and establish grandfather-rights for existing signs. This would essentially eliminate the requirement for sign owners to replace the undesirable signs that the ordinance was originally targeting, and stall or permanently halt the beautification of streets throughout the city, such as Muldoon, which currently suffer a "sign blight".

Accordingly, the following motion was made:

The NECC opposes any further changes to sign ordinance amortization schedule.
