At the North East Community Council Membership Meeting held on February 18th, 2010, the following resolutions were presented from the floor and voted on.

1. A Resolution: <u>NECC February 18, 2010, concerning the 120 Legislative Session.</u>

Be it hereby resolved, the Northeast Community Council requests and supports a 120 day legislative session to allow more time for the general public to weigh in on issues and also give our legislators adequate time to work through these issues in a calm and deliberate manner.

A vote on the motion: 7 in favor, 11 opposed, 4 abstained. The motion failed.

2. A Resolution: NECC February 18, 2010, concerning the Centennial Park and Campground.

The NECC requests that our representatives in Juneau find the 3.8 million dollars to purchase the land known as the Muldoon Park Strip so that Muldoon can retain Centennial Park as is and gain the land for the land known as the old greenhouse property.

A vote on the resolution: In favor 16, Opposed 0, Abstained 4. The motion passed.

3. A Resolution: <u>NECC February 18, 2010, concerning funding for the Centennial Park and Campground.</u>

The NECC requests a minimum of \$500,000 from the State of Alaska to renovate and upgrade the facility known as Centennial Park Campground in order to bring it up to code and public standards for current and future anticipated increases in use.

A vote on the motion: 17 in favor, 0 opposed, 5 abstained. Motion passed.

4. A Resolution: NECC February 18, 2010, concerning MOA Case #S11791-1.

On the matter of MOA Case S11791-1: We hereby resolve the proposed vacation and/or relocation of the existing eight foot side visual enhancement easement located North of Whisperwood Park Drive and West of Turpin Street shall be approved.

A vote on the motion: 12 in favor, 2 opposed, 4 abstaining. Motion passed.

5. A Resolution: <u>NECC February 18, 2010, concerning MOA Case #S11560-1.</u> In regards to MOA Case S11560-1: Be it hereby resolved, the Northeast Community Council supports the acquisition of additional right of way to establish turn lanes for traffic safety purposes.

A vote on the motion: 15 in favor, 0 opposed, 4 abstained. Motion passed.
